
Replacing Your Broken Snap

Remove the old snap with bolt cutters or similar means. Do not cut the rope. Do not pull the rope apart.

<u>Note:</u> When removing and/or replacing the snap, you may have to spread the loop end of the rope slightly to take the old snap off and also to get the new replacement snap on.

Using a Phillips head screw driver, remove the screw on the side of the snap. (Figure



- ◆ Take the new snap and slide the open end through the "eye" in the rope.
- Once the snap is threaded through the eye of the rope, you are ready to tighten the snap closed.
- Using a Phillips head screw driver, tighten the screw supplied with the snap.
- Your rope is now ready to use.
